 - b. LEAs will need to **provide a typed narrative response regardless** of Title IV-A amount allocated.
 - c. LEAs will need to <u>check appropriate "sub-categories"</u> under Narrative Questions 1, 2, and 3.
- 6) Title IV-A Allocation Worksheet- now embedded within the application
 - a. LEAs will be *required* to <u>complete</u> this new section which illustrates how funds will be spent within the three content areas: Well-Rounded Education, Safe & Healthy Students, Effective Use of Technology.
 - b. All LEA's should complete the Budget Summary Section
 - c. It is imperative that you complete the correct section of this worksheet: LEA ALLOCATION UNDER \$30,000.00 *or*, LEA ALLOCATION \$30,000.00 OR MORE.
