Low Risk: Three or more years with no change in program administrator			
Program Activities, Progress Testing:			
High Risk –In a fiscal year, programs have less than 65% of participants progress-tested	10	5	0
Medium Risk - In a fiscal year Programs have 65% -74% participants progress-tested			
Low Risk - In a fiscal year Programs have 75% or more participants progress tested			
Unresolved Corrective Actions:			
High Risk – No requested corrective actions have been resolved by due date	10	5	0

Low Risk – Any requested corrective actions have been resolved			
Timely Submission of Reports:
