**F. KEY LEGISLATION AND GUIDANCE**

The Johnson-O'Malley (JOM) Program is authorized by the Johnson-O'Malley Act of 1934 and the implementing regulations are provided in Part 273 of Title 25 of the Code of Federal Regulations. As amended, this Act authorizes contracts for the education of eligible Indian students enrolled in public schools. Such contracts shall be for the purpose of financially assisting those efforts designed to meet the specialized and unique educational needs of eligible Indian students, including programs supplemental to the regular school program and school operational support, where such support is necessary to maintain State educational standards. Guidance is provided via the Office of Indian Education website and through JOM training.

**G. SUMMARY OF ALLOCATION METHODOLOGY**

Once the contract is issued to the Office of Indian Education, an administrative set aside is calculated at approximately 20%. This includes funding to cover conference registration fees in the form of scholarships to ADE's JOM-eligible LEAs.

The remaining 80% is allocated to the LEAs based on a per pupil amount (PPA). That amount is determined by dividing the 80% figure by the total number of eligible students across all eligible LEAs. Currently, that number is based on 1995 student counts. Once the PPA is determined, that figure is multiplied by individual LEAs' student counts for their total allocation
