Comply with ARS § 15-779.01, Arizona State Board of Education Rule R7-2406 and serve all eligible gifted students in grades K-12, as applicable. Submit evidence through assuring in your application that teachers who have primary responsibility for teaching gifted students have obtained or are working towards obtaining the gifted education endorsement. Determine LEA prior year October 1st enrollment data for eligible LEA cohort Calculate LEA allocations per ARS §15.779.03: \$75 per pupil for 4% of the district's October 1st enrollment, or \$2,000, whichever is more. Adjust funding formula as needed based on the amount available for LEA Assistance.
