With fewer state dollars available, attention turns to federal funds – and compliance with federal regulations becomes even more critical. All federal education grant funds received by local districts (LEAs) and Charters through the Arizona Department of Education are subject to the Uniform Grant Guidance (UGG) (updated in August 2020!) and the Education Department General Administrative Regulations (EDGAR). In addition, LEAs and Charters received new federal funding through the CARES Act, CRRSAA, and the American Rescue Plan (ARP), with new requirements, periods of availability, and plenty of challenges.

New to navigating these rules? Interested in receiving the latest federal financial, regulatory and legislative developments? The Arizona Department of Education has asked the federal education firm in D.C., Brustein & Manasevit, PLLC, to lead a two-series virtual workshop: the first part will cover requirements under the UGG and EDGAR, as well as technical revisions by the Office of Management and Budget, and flexibilities offered related to disruptions caused by COVID-19 and related school closures; the second part will highlight CARES Act, CRRSAA and ARP funding, including allowable uses and audit preparation, legislative developments and federal policy changes.
