- CTDS numbers for school sites.
- Grade spans include the lowest grade served up to the highest grade served within the range of K-12. Do not use Ungraded (UG) in this span.
- Enrollment reflects the number of students enrolled in K-12 during the prior year from either the 40th Day, 100th Day, or AzEDS Oct 1 Enrollment (filtered for K-12). Do not use HNS enrollment.
- Poverty percentage is verified and aligned to the data source listed on the Poverty Criteria Page.
- School Improvement label reflects current status. (Note: this may change at the beginning of the 22-23 School Year.)
