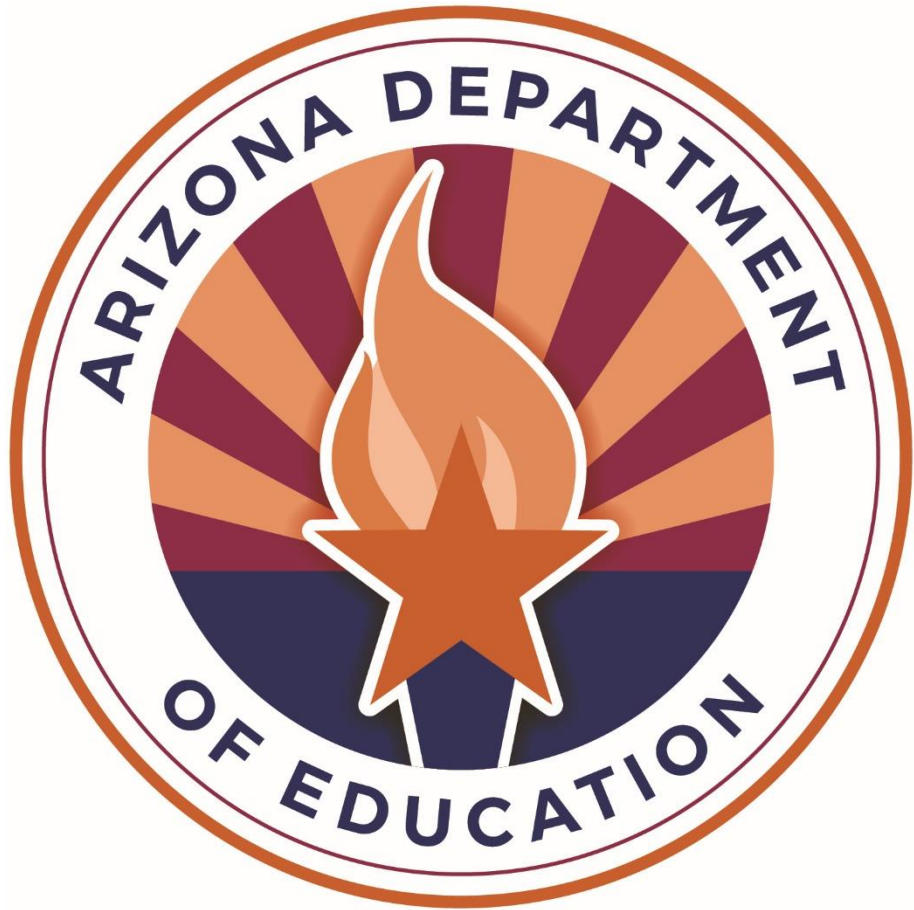

ESSER Funds – USED LEA Data Reporting Requirements

- The US Department of Education has released final data collection reporting requirements for all ESSER fund grants (ESSER I, II and III). Comprehensive data are required to be submitted by states (SEAs) and LEAs regarding their usage of ESSER grant funds.
- Data must be reported for all ESSER I, II and/or III grants with allocations and/or expenditures from **July 1, 2022 through June 30 2023**.
- Please review all page instructions before entering responses as some pages require reporting for expenditures **paid** via reimbursement request in GME during this period. Other pages are general data gathering **not** tied to expenditures paid.
- Most of the required data elements (fiscal, program and personnel) are not currently captured through existing ADE collections
- Data response types include a combination of Y/N (or True/False) and open-ended responses (as applicable). For grants with no allocation or expenditures paid OR no expenditure activity, enter "\$0.00" and/or "N/A" where applicable.
