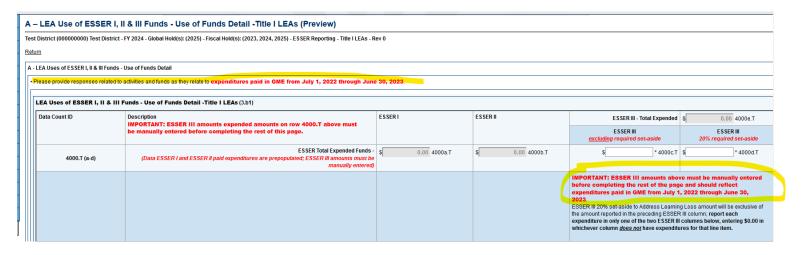

In many cases that information does not specify the need to drill down to the granular level, particularly on student counts, FTEs, etc.

Additional information for questions regarding activities, counts, etc. that are NOT tied to expenditures paid is also provided based on our understanding of US Ed requirements.

For questions relating to ESSER program content or general content reporting not related to expenditures please contact your ESSER program area team.

- 1. Total Student Enrollment by Demographic page "Must equal sum of total counts on rows 700.NT 713.NT"
- a. This instruction has been removed from both the Non-Title I LEA and Title I LEA reports. If you can still see this please refresh your connection to GME and it should no longer appear. If for any reason it is still present, please disregard.
- **2**. What date are you wanting us to use for the Student Demographics? The 100<sup>th</sup> day data? Or are you seeking data from May 1, 2023, or some other date in time?
- a. This question is represented on the report as provided from US Ed. Our general understanding is that they are asking for high level information, anticipating that it will be rolled up and aggregated by state. To our knowledge this is not being collected for individual entity audit purposes. Data provided here should be entered using the method you would normally utilize provide this information for any other general reporting.
- **3**. Part B, application states to add numbers from total expended for all ESSER. When those numbers are pulled, they include all years and not just FY23. Is it for all years or what's been expended from FY23?
- a. Clarification has been provided regarding multiple pages (see first page of this communication). Additionally, the "Use of Funds" pages have had the instructions corrected as shown below:
  - The <u>ESSER Total Allocated and Expended Funds</u> page will reflect pre-populated data as follows:
    - Total amount awarded = TOTAL Award amount for each grant
    - o Total amount **expended** = Expenditures **paid** in GME from July 1, 2022 June 30, 2023
  - > Both A & B "Use of Funds.." pages:
    - Advise to provide responses based on Expenditures paid dates in GME for reimbursements that are paid from July 1, 2022 through June, 30, 2023
    - On the "B" page, activities may have occurred prior to July 1, but the response is tied to when expenditures were reimbursed (July 1 through June 30, 2023), not when the activities or original expenditures occurred
  - > NON expenditure related pages:
    - For pages requiring responses for activities, demographics and other counts that DO NOT require a response inclusive of expenditures paid data, count data would be general data gathering and should reflect data for the state fiscal year of July 1, 2022 June 30, 2023

IMPORTANT: Expenditures in ESSER Reporting are related to <u>Expenditures that were paid via</u> reimbursement request in GME. You CANNOT use your own reports of when you actually expended the funds, but instead need to utilize the paid amounts.

- **4**. The Report on Part B- LEA use of ESSER states the dates July 1, 2022- September 30,2022. Powerpoint and Programs Instruction sections states July 1, 2022-June 30,2023.

- **5.** Could please confirm if are we supposed to use July 1, 2022-June 30,2023 for the entire report?
  - a. See the response to #3 above
- b. For activities, demographics and other counts that **DO NOT** require a response inclusive of expenditures paid data, count data would be general data gathering and should reflect data for the state fiscal year of July 1, 2022 June 30, 2023
- **6.** Powerpoint states due May 9 but Program Instructions states May 10 for submission deadline.
- a. The submission deadline has been extended to Thursday, May 16th (11:59pm)
- **7.** Can you please clarify who should be included under bilingual educators? Is this only teachers that are teaching a second language or is it all educators who are bilingual
- a. Grants Management does not have this information and the information from US Ed is general in nature. Please see the response for #2 above. As with all data not related to expenditures it seems that this data is being gathered in a high level manner in order to aggregate all of it to an overall state count.
- b. PLEASE CONTACT YOUR ESSER PROGRAM AREA TEAM FOR FURTHER INFORMATION ON THIS AREA. GRANTS MANAGEMENT CANNOT PROVIDE FURTHER GUIDANCE.
- 8. We need further clarification on what specific job titles/descriptions you want us to include under the "Access to Select Staff" report and specifically the "Special educators and related service personnel, including paraprofessionals" section. Could you please list the job titles you want included or the job descriptions?
- a. Please see responses to #2 and #7. Grants Management does not have this information and the information from US Ed is general in nature. As with all data not related to expenditures it seems that this data is being gathered in a high level manner in order to aggregate all of it to an overall state count.
- **9.** We are having issues when we try to enter the CTDS number for the school on the "Access to Select Staff" page. It automatically removes the zero at the beginning of the number and then adds commas. Example: we enter 070204101 and it changes it to 70,204,101.
- a. This was previously corrected. If you are still seeing it please refresh your connection to GME and try again. If for any reason this is still showing do not worry about it as we will correct this once we pull down all data once the reporting period has closed.
- **10.** In the "LEA Hiring and Retention Specific Positions" section, can you confirm that we are reporting using the July 1, 2022 June 30, 2023 date range?
- a. Please see response to question # 5. For activities, demographics and other counts that DO require a response inclusive of expenditures paid data, count data would be general data gathering and should reflect data during the state fiscal year of July 1, 2022 June 30, 2023
- **11. (a)** In the "Access to Select Staff" section, are we reporting to the select staff paid for out of an ESSER fund or are we reporting all staff regardless of funding source? **(b)** Also, again can you clarify the date or date range we are required to utilize?
- a. The requirements provided by US Ed do not specify that responses are tied to staff paid our of ESSER funds, but only ask to provide the count of FTE staff assigned to serve each school in the LEA in the categories specified. It would seem to be general data gathering for the purpose of aggregating data up roll up to total counts for the state.
- b. Please see response to question # 5. For activities, demographics and other counts that DO require a response inclusive of expenditures paid data, count data would be general data gathering and should reflect data for the state fiscal year of July 1, 2022 June 30, 2023

- **12.** If as an LEA we feel that the dollar amount shown as the total amount expended and reimbursed for in ESSER II that is automatically being populated by ADE, what is the suggested recourse?
  - a. Please see response to question 3.
