Single Audit Questionnaire **Fast Facts**



The Single Audit Qualifier Questionnaire (SAQQ) is a two question document that must be completed annually by all LEAs within the Grants Management Enterprise (GME) System.

Does your organization expend \$750,000.00 in Federal grant funds annually?

If yes, then a Single Audit must be completed by a contracted third-party CPA.

If **no**, then a Single Audit is not required.

LEA Single Audit Started:

The next step is to upload the completed SARP when provided by your third-party CPA.

Required:

Single Audit Qualifier Questionnaire (SAQQ) is complete.

No further action needed, unless requested by ADE.

The Single Audit Reporting Package (SARP), must be uploaded in GME no later than 9 months after your organization's fiscal year end date, or within 30 days after receiving your SARP from a third-party CPA, whichever occurs first. No other action is required between "LEA Single Audit Started" and this upload.

Single Audit Questionnaire Frequently Asked Questions



1. Do I need to complete the Single Audit Qualifier Questionnaire (SAQQ)?

Yes. All LEAs must complete the Single Audit Qualifier Questionnaire (SAQQ) annually.

2. My LEA expended less than \$750,000. Do we still need to complete the Single Audit Qualifier Questionnaire (SAQQ)?

<u>Yes.</u> All LEAs, regardless of expenditure, must complete the Single Audit Qualifier Questionnaire (SAQQ).

3. I completed the questionnaire. The status in GME says "LEA Single Audit Not Required. What do I do now?

You have completed the Single Audit Qualifier Questionnaire (SAQQ). **No further action is** needed, unless requested by ADE.

4. I completed the questionnaire. The status in GME says "LEA Single Audit Started". What do I do now?

Contract a third-party CPA to complete the Single Audit Reporting Package (SARP). **No other action is needed**, until the SARP is completed and ready to be uploaded into the Grants Management Enterprise (GME) System.

5. What do I do with the Single Audit Reporting Package (SARP) completed by our CPA? The SARP must be uploaded into the Grants Managment Enterprise (GME) System. The report is due no later than 9 months after your organization's fiscal year end date, or within 30 days of receiving it from your CPA, whichever comes first.

6. I accidentally answered the Single Audit Qualifier Questionnaire (SAQQ) incorrectly. What do I do?
