



Title VI Assurances Announcement

What is the Title VI Assurance?

Title VI of federal civil rights law is clear that no person shall be discriminated on the basis of race, skin color or ethnicity. The 14th amendment to the Constitution says the same thing. By contrast, the use of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion programs does just the opposite and promotes racial discrimination. That has no place in education or society. The Arizona Department of Education has been tasked with collecting documentation of our federal grant subrecipient's adherence via the Title VI Assurance. This information will be collected via your Grants Management Enterprise (GME) LEA Document Library. The assurance documentation MUST be submitted by April 14, 2025. Organizations that do not meet this requirement may be placed on hold.

Accessing the Title VI Assurance Template

1. Login to Grants Management Enterprise (GME)
2. Access the LEA Document Library using the main GME me
